

Gali Vineyards offers estate-grown, award-winning wines in a welcoming, family-owned tasting room in downtown Los Gatos, California. As grape growers and small business owners we have always put the land first.

Our 18 acres of vineyards are farmed by hand by Dr. Joseph Gali, a pediatrician with a passion for cultivation and sustainable farming. Just six miles from the Pacific Ocean, the rows of chardonnay, pinot noir, syrah, tempranillo and albariño grow in soil composed of gravely loam with clay on decomposed sandstone. We are currently the only producer of tempranillo (first vintage in 2016) in the Santa Cruz Mountains AVA and have won double gold, gold and silver medals for our wines.

Splitting his week between caring for his patients and caring for his grapes, Joseph coaxes wine grapes from bud break to harvest using eco-responsible practices. The cool marine air preserves acidity in the grapes as they develop bright fruit flavors, thicker skins and more intense color.

These vineyards bring joy – not just for the ripe fruit they yield, but for the peaceful days in nature. Honoring the power of the sun and its role in building the texture, flavors and complexities in our wines, an ancient sun disk symbol adorns our bottles.
